COLLECTION SUMMARY

The majority of the Rick Ludwin Collection focuses primarily on NBC TV primetime and late-night programming from the 1980s and 1990s, with several items from more recent years.

These items include:

- magnetic and vinyl media, containing NBC broadcast programs and “FOR YOUR CONSIDERATION” awards compilations
- program scripts, treatments, and rehearsal schedules
- industry publications
- national news clippings
- awards program catalogs
- internal network communications, and
- camera-ready advertising copy

Included in the collection are historical narratives of broadcast radio and television and the history of NBC, including various mergers and acquisitions over the years.

Other special interests highlighted by this collection include:

Materials pertaining to other personalities and programs such as The Carson Daily Show, Christmas specials, etc., are included, but not to the extent as those mentioned above.

Fifteen original *Seinfeld* table scripts are included here; most of which were working copies, reflecting the use of multi-colored pages to highlight draft revisions. Other scripts are contained here--some for primetime, some for broadcast specials such as the landmark three-hour broadcast of SNL'S 25th Anniversary. Several of the scripts include hand notes, presumed to be those of Rick Ludwin.

Other documents in this collection are industry-specific, including external as well as internal program development reports, annual independent seasonal reviews (covering all major networks), ratings reports, etc. There are also several awards program catalogs for events ranging from The Emmys to The 23rd American Film Institute Life Achievement Award--given to Steven Spielberg.

As an added bonus, there are two books commemorating the 15th and 20th anniversaries of The Comedy Store, which opened its doors on the Sunset Strip in 1972. These provide biographical and anecdotal information and (tons of) photographs of the people who have and continue to impact a broad sector within the American entertainment industry.

All items in this collection are authentic and organized chronologically by series.

PROVENANCE OF THE COLLECTION

This collection was assembled by Rick Ludwin and donated to The Walter Havighurst Special Collections at Miami University, Oxford, Ohio.

RICK LUDWIN BIOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION

Although personal information about Rick Ludwin is scarce, one source states him to have been born on May 27, 1948.

Attaining a BA in Speech Communication from Miami University in 1970, Ludwin went on to complete a MA at Northwestern University. He soon began working in broadcasting for Chicago and Detroit TV stations, then moved on to writing for Bob Hope and Mike Douglas. In a temporary stint for NBC Ludwin helped to produce "Olympathon '79" and "America Alive! During this time, he met and impressed Brandon Tartikoff, then-President of NBC in New York.

Ludwin was offered the position of director of variety shows at NBC in 1980. Within three years he was made vice president:

- 1980 director of variety shows
- 1983 vice president for specials and variety programs
- 1989 senior vice president for specials, variety programs and late-night
- 2007 executive vice president for late-night and primetime series

Looking back on his early years with the network Ludwin says, "I thought I'd be here a year and be fired or would leave out of frustration, and here I am all these years later. It worked out pretty well."

Ludwin is credited for the success of shows like *The Tonight Show*, *Late Night with Conan O'Brien*, *Saturday Night Live* and *Seinfeld*. He has served as writer, producer, and executive for numerous NBC hit programs since the '80s, including a cameo appearance (as himself) in one episode of *Seinfeld*.

Being the "longest-tenured employee at NBC," Ludwin is known to be somewhat of a fighter. Ludwin "rises up in meetings to argue for what he believes...but rarely stands up to take a bow," according to Warren Littlefield, former executive at NBC Entertainment. "Without Ludwin, there would have been no *Seinfeld*. He commissioned the pilot, took money out of his specials budget to keep the show alive and oversaw the program for its entire run." Ludwin's reply, "I don't put that in the category of death-defying leaps. That's what we're supposed to be doing."

In his college days at Miami University, in Oxford, Ohio, Ludwin hosted "Studio 14," a variety-comedy show on Miami's WMUB-TV station. He and classmates wrote, produced, directed, and acted the entire live show. "I had this love for live television. There was nothing more exciting," says Ludwin.

His connections to Miami University remain strong, visiting the campus each year to talk with students in the Communications Department and participating annually during Alumni Reunion. Through the Ludwin connection, Miami has been able to secure campus appearances by Bob Hope and Jay Leno.
